4. COURSES, SEMINARS AND WORKSHOPS

5. IMPLEMENTATION AND MONITORING

For effective implementation and monitoring of the Program, TSTPL and BJI agrees that:

- a. The interaction between TSTPL and BJI will be implemented by creating a 'Program Coordination Cell' both at TSTPL and BJI each headed by a Program Coordinator.
- b. The Program Coordinator for the respective party to this MoU will be nominated by the authorized representative of TSTPL and BJI.
- c. The Program Coordination Cell members will meet at regular intervals for reviewing the progress.
- d. If the activities could result in the form of publication/patent, then the IPR will be with both the institutions with due percentage share that is to be mutually agreed upon.



6. FINANCE

Regarding the Financial arrangements during the Programme Implementation, TSTPL and BJI agrees that:

- a. Both the parties will utilize the services of their existing faculty and staff for this program.
- b. Both the parties will utilize their available infrastructure at both ends for this collaborative arrangement.

7. CONFIDENTIALITY AND NON-DISCLOSURE

Any software/hardware material, product specifications, designs, financial, information, documents etc., shall be deemed to be in private domain and it shall not be made public or shared with any other party without the prior written consent of the party which owns it. Any material and/or information that is used for the effective implementation and/or operation of this MoU shall be treated with utmost confidentiality for a period of at least 3 years after this MOU comes to an end or as explicitly agreed from time to time in writing.

8. DURATION

This MoU will be active initially for a period of 3 years from the date of execution of this MoU. The duration of extension, if any, will be mutually decided by both parties based on the outcome of the collaboration.

9. ARBITRATION

In the event of any disputes or differences between the parties hereto, such disputes or difference shall be resolved amicably by mutual consultation. If such disputes or difference is not resolved within 30 days, then the unresolved disputes or difference shall be referred to a mutually acceptable sole arbitrator, appointed by both parties. The Arbitration proceeding shall be as per the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996. The decision of the Arbitrator shall be final and binding upon parties to the dispute. The arbitration proceeding shall be held at Kollam. The language of arbitration shall be English. The honorable Courts of Kollam district shall have the exclusive jurisdiction to try any dispute arising out of this MOU.

10. TERMINATION OF MOU

This MoU may be terminated by either party by giving a written notice of three calendar months to be issued vide post with due acknowledgement. The notice is to enable the parties hereto to assess the monetary impact and such other related factors impinging on the interests of both the parties by mutual consent. Termination will be effective, subject to honoring of any valid financial/technical/administrative commitments till the date and receipt of notice of termination.
