Alumni talk Series Report

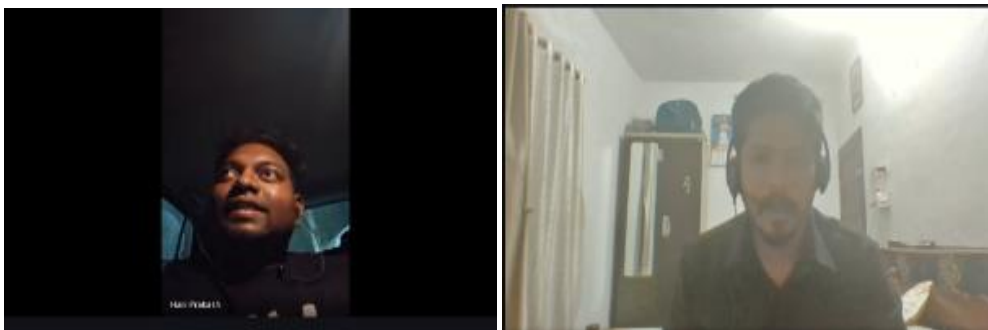

A total of 40 plus students attended this outstanding session to get answers to their questions about placements, further education, certification courses.

The session was completed in three days with three resource person from various departments

Day 1 (21-04-25)
