

ADMISSION POLICY

Process and Procedure:

1) ELIGIBILITY:

a) Nationality:

Candidates must be citizens of India for general category admission.

b) Age:

- For B.Tech. & B.Arch. admissions applicants should have completed 17 years of age as at 31st of December.
- As for MBA, there is no specific upper-age limit for admission. However, the applicant should hold a bachelors degree or equivalent in any subject.

c) Academic Requirements (for B.Tech. and B.Arch.):

Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examination, Kerala, or Examinations recognized as equivalent thereto, with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects and Chemistry as one of the optional subjects with at least a combined marks of 50% are eligible for admission for:

- All B.Tech. Engineering programs (Civil, Mechanical, Electrical, Electronics, Computer Science, Data Science and Artificial Intelligence)
- Architecture and Design program

However, eligibility criteria for reservation category is 45% marks.

d) Entrance Examination for B.Tech. & B.Arch.

Candidates are mandatorily required to qualify in:

- the KEAM (Kerala Engineering Architecture and Medical) examination conducted by the Commissioner of Entrance Exams, Govt. of Kerala, or JEE (Joint Entrance Examination) unless otherwise explicit exemptions are granted by the Government of Kerala, from time to time for any B.Tech. related programs
- the NATA (National Aptitude Test in Architecture) examination conducted by the Council of Architecture, for B.Arch. program.

For B. Tech., the candidate is required to score at least 10 marks out of 300 for General and SEBC candidates; while for B.Arch. a mere pass mark on NATA exam is required.

e) Academic Requirements (for MBA):

Candidates who have passed any approved graduation program or examinations recognized as equivalent thereto, with at least 50% marks (45% marks for reservation category) are eligible for admission, and the below criteria shall apply.

f) Entrance Examination for MBA:

Candidates are mandatorily required to qualify in the KMAT (Kerala Management Aptitude Test) examination conducted by the Commissioner of Entrance Exams, Govt. of Kerala, or any similar aptitude test conducted by a recognised Agency (CMAT, CAT, etc...), unless otherwise explicit exemptions are granted by the Government of Kerala, from time to time.

The candidate is required to score at least 72 marks out of 720 for General and SEBC candidates, and 54 marks for SC/ST/PWD candidates. The cut off marks may vary from year to year.
